Officers and remuneration.

**331.** (1) The Governor may appoint such additional officers as may be required for the execution of this Part, and may remove any person so appointed.

(2) The Governor shall direct whether any and what remuneration is to be allowed to any officer of, or person performing any duties under this Part in relation to the winding up of companies, and may vary, increase or diminish that remuneration as he thinks fit.

Returns by officers in winding up.

**332.** The official receiver and any officer of the Court acting in the winding up of companies shall make to the Accountant-General such returns of their business in connection therewith, at such times, and in such manner and form, as the Accountant-General may direct, and from those returns the Accountant-General may cause books to be prepared which shall, under Regulations made by the Governor in Council, be open for public information and searches.
